#### **NBEMS**

Narrow Band Emergency Message System (NBEMS) is a method of communicating with a computer and a HAM radio to send digital messages. The message is typed into the message screen or on a predesigned form and the transfer is done by placing the transmitting radio microphone next to the computer's speaker. The free computer software consists of three elements, FLDIGI, FLWRAP, and FLMSG. The NBEMS Net meet on the air at 7:00 pm on the 2nd and 4th Thursday of the month on 145.645 MHz, FM.
